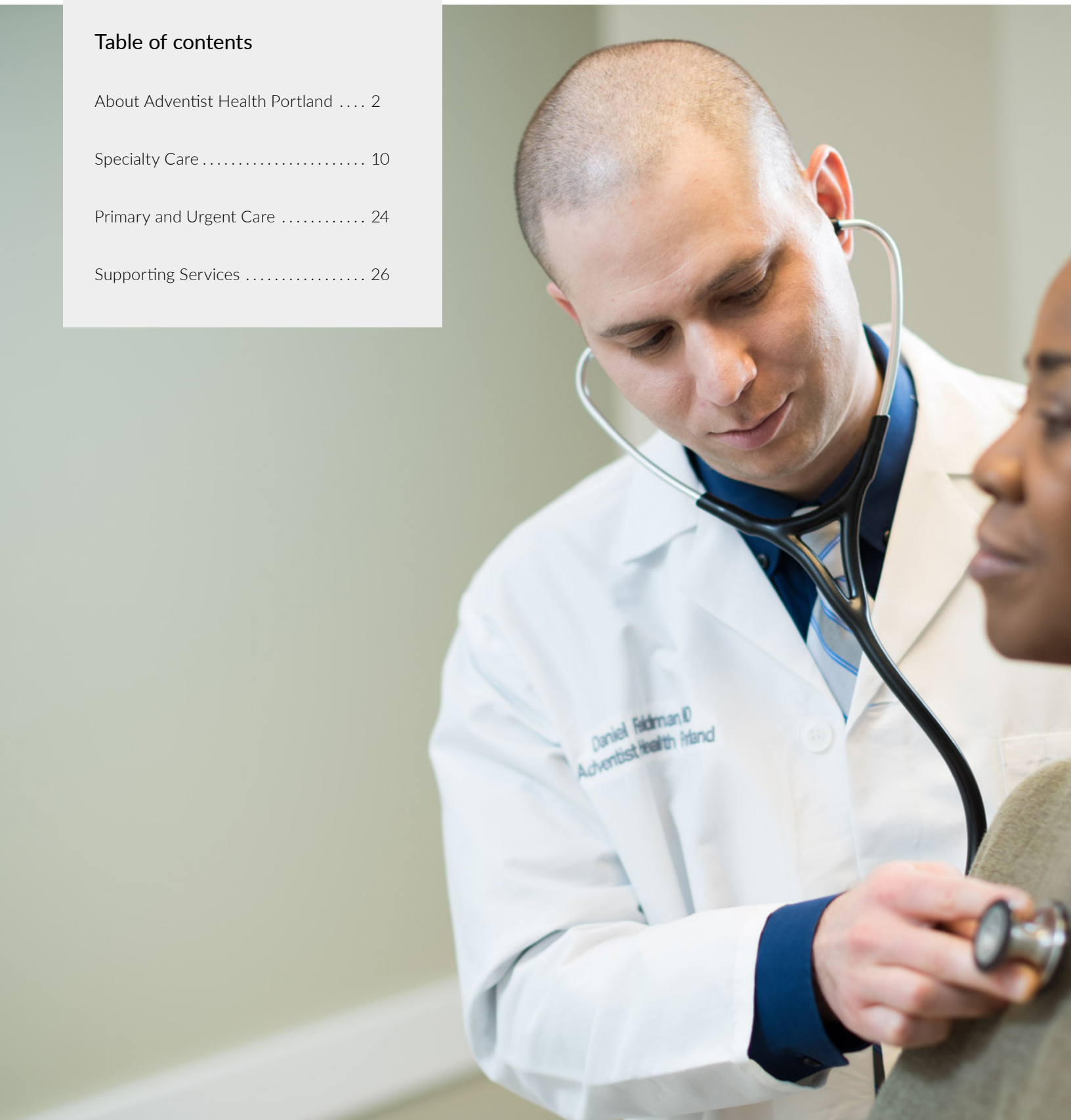

Adventist Medical Center

Our hospital campus provides surgical and inpatient care as well outpatient primary and specialty care clinics and services in our pavilion and professional buildings.

The hospital facilities include:

- Advanced medical imaging
- Birth center, Level I nursery and teleNICU
- Cardiac catheterization lab
- Cardiovascular intensive care unit
- Emergency room
- Intensive care unit
- Laboratory services
- Medical/surgical inpatient rooms
- Specialty pharmacy
- State-of-the-art operating rooms

Emergency room

Emergency care is at the heart of our mission to care for our diverse urban community. Our ER includes 32 rooms.

We see more cardiac arrests than the next two area hospitals combined.

Cardiovascular intensive care unit and cath lab

During a heart attack, time is muscle. Our 12-bed CVICU and state-of-the-art cath lab are closely connected to our ER to provide exceptional and quick cardiac emergency care as well as ongoing cardiac treatment. We were the first hospital in the area to incorporate universal beds into our cardiac program to increase patient safety and satisfaction.

Surgery services

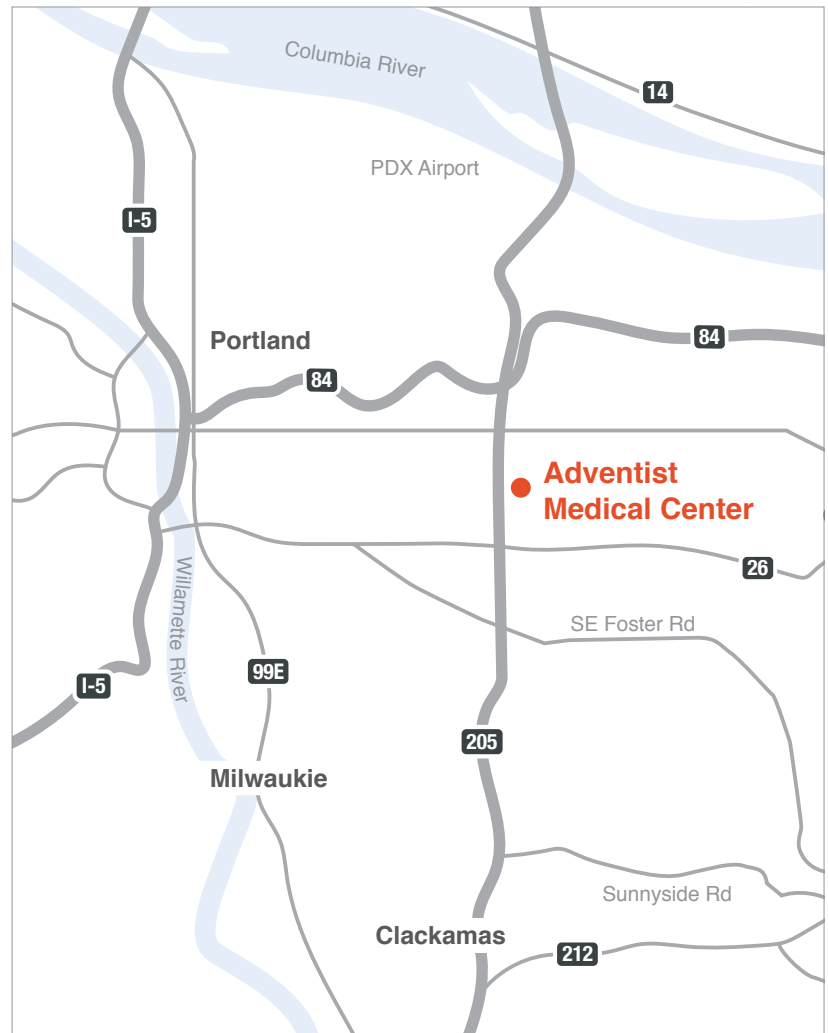
Our surgery department includes 11 operating rooms and provides a comprehensive range of surgical specialties, including offering minimally invasive and Da Vinci robot procedures when appropriate. We perform more than 6,200 surgeries annually in our main OR alone.

Intensive care units

Our med/surg ICU has 12 beds. Our nurses are supported by a 1:1 or 1:2 nurse/patient ratio, constant observers as needed and continuous patient monitoring through OHSU's virtual ICU program.

Laboratory services

Our full-service, fully accredited clinical laboratory serves physicians, clinics, nursing homes and hospitals throughout the Portland/Vancouver metropolitan area and other communities. Our services include all routine and most special and esoteric tests. The lab is directed by board-certified pathologists and medical technologist specialists.



Family Birth Place

Our Family Birth Place brings together obstetricians, family practice physicians, nurse-midwives, anesthesiologists, and some of the most experienced labor and delivery nurses in the area. Many have special certifications, such as fetal monitoring and lactation support.

The Family Birth Place also offers a Level 1 nursery, breastfeeding support, and classes in childbirth and newborn care. If an infant requires advanced care, we transport the baby with OHSU's trained team to the OHSU Doernbecher's Level 4 neonatal intensive care unit (NICU). We have telemedicine support with neonatologists at OHSU when we need a consultation about an infant.

Radiation oncology

Our radiation oncology team offers many up-to-date technologies including:

- Image-guided radiation therapy (IGRT)
- Intensity-modulated radiation therapy (IMRT)
- Stereotactic body radiation therapy (SBRT)
- Volumetric modulated arc therapy (VMAT)

Many patients combine radiation with other treatments like hormone therapy, chemotherapy and/or surgery.

Cancer surgery

Our cancer care program offers a full complement of cancer surgeries, including:

- Breast
- Colorectal
- Gynecological, including cervical, uterine and ovarian
- Lung, esophageal and thoracic
- Pancreas, liver and bile ducts
- Urological, including bladder, prostate, testicular and kidney, in partnership with OHSU Urology on our campus

Many of our cancer patients benefit from our extensive minimally invasive surgical options using the Da Vinci surgical robot.

Gastrointestinal (GI) issues can often cause serious discomfort and pain, making life more difficult. Our experienced gastroenterology providers utilize the latest advancements to care for and diagnose our patients.

Our expertise and advanced technology are why many doctors refer their patients to us when they suspect a GI issue. Our complete diagnostic program includes:

High-risk pregnancy care

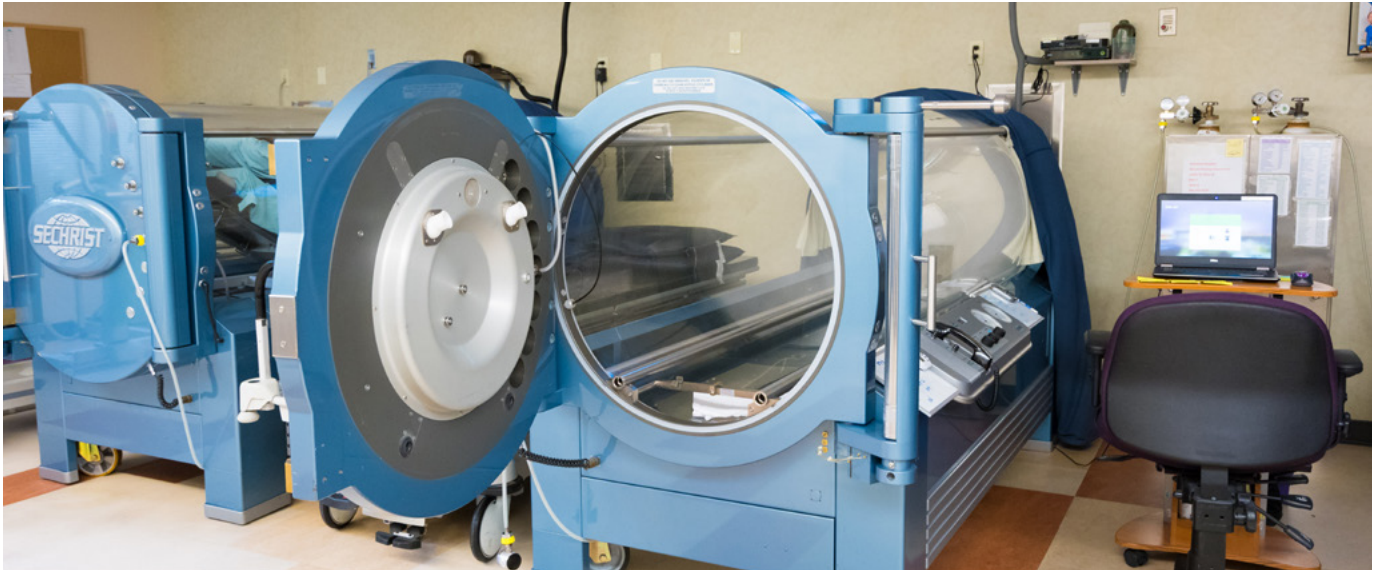

Hyperbaric medicine in Portland

As an adjunct to treatment of wounds, hyperbaric oxygen therapy has been found to increase the healing potential of your body's natural mechanisms. 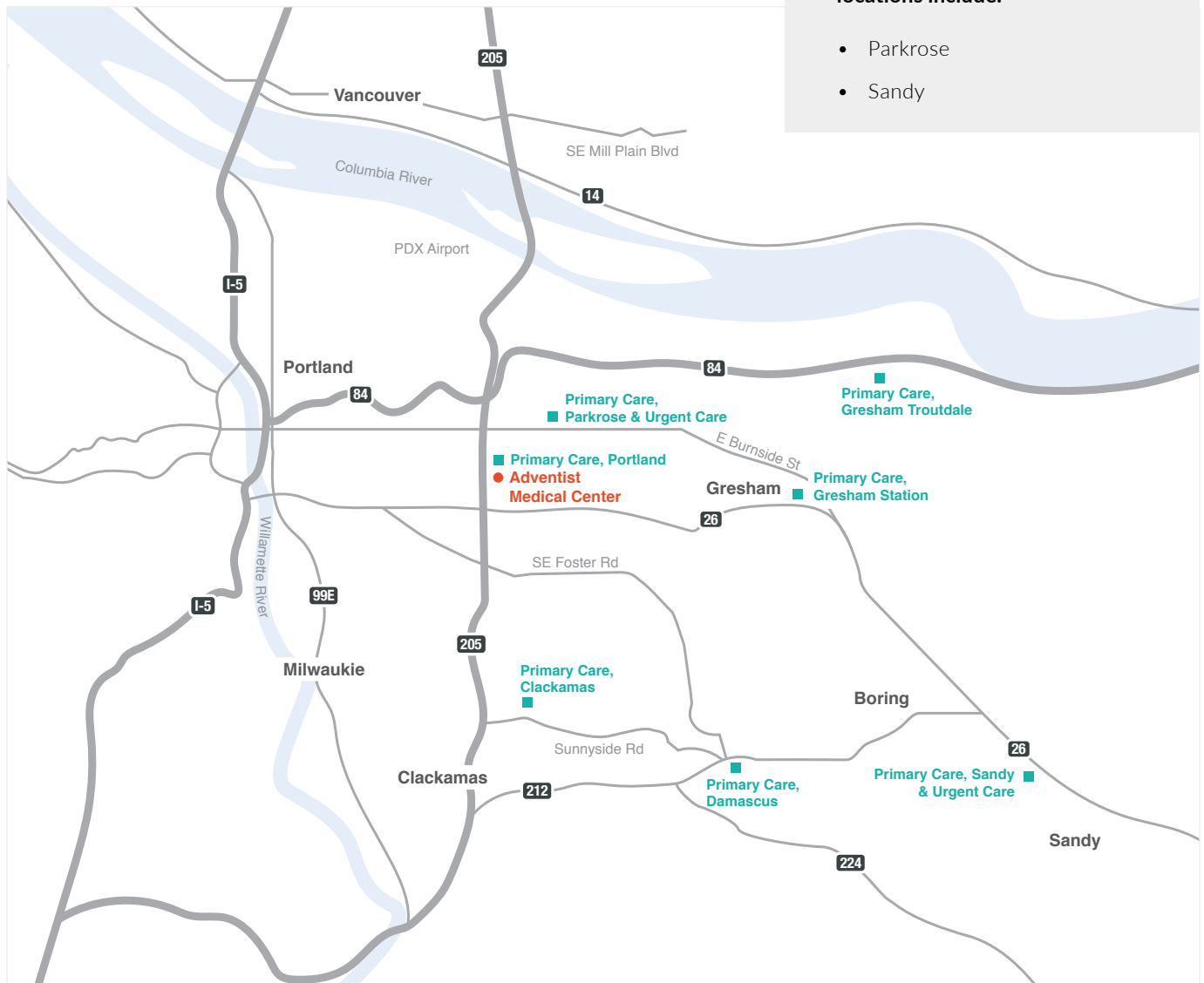

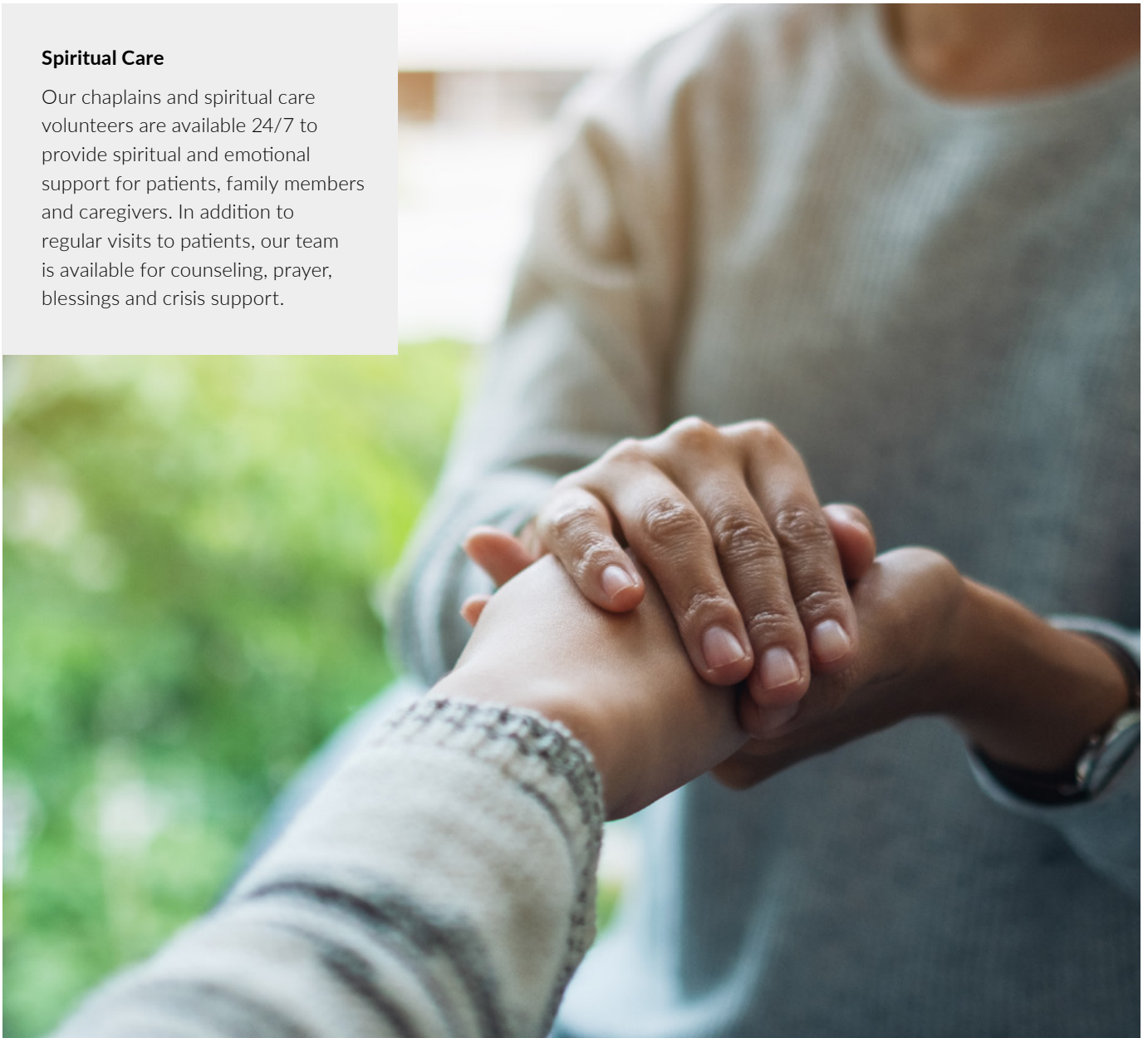

Team-based palliative care

Doctors, nurses, mental and physical therapists, pharmacists, and other professionals work together help our patients manage the symptoms of their illnesses, which may include pain, nausea, depression, anxiety, stress and fatigue. Some patients have difficulty breathing, eating or sleeping.

Unlike hospice, palliative care can be offered to patients of any age and at any stage of an illness. Choosing palliative care does not prevent patients from seeking or receiving curative treatment. Care is provided at any residence, whether at home or an assisted living facility.

Our hospice team offers compassionate, supportive care for patients with life-limiting illnesses who wish to live out the remainder of their lives on their own terms. We focus on preserving the dignity and privacy of the patient while providing relief from the symptoms of their illness.
